

Mountain Archaeology Beyond Borders

The Department of Humanities at the University of Trento and the Department of Archaeologies at the University of Innsbruck share a common interest in mountain archaeology and the human dwelling in the Alps.

To strengthen connections between the archaeological communities of Trentino and North Tyrol, members of the two institutions will participate in a 3-day exchange visit organized under the EUREGIO Mobility Fund*.

The program includes presentations, laboratory and facility tours, as well as field trips to significant archaeological sites. It will offer all participants an introduction to geo-, archaeological and palaeoenvironmental research on both sides of the Eastern Alps.

- **Eligibility:** BA, MA, and PhD students working on the interaction between humans and the mountain environment.
