





- → invariance of time and place
- → ubiquitously (virtual) availability of information

Curriculum, online and distance learning including television or radio


GEC actions in this area included:


- Design and preparation of alternative education delivery systems, including mobilizing resources and support options from global Coalition partners and accelerating the deployment of gender-responsive distance learning approaches and girls' digital skills development to narrow the gender digital skills divide.
- Gap analysis and assessment of curriculum and available digital resources.
- Support for teaching and learning platform development.
- Digitization of curriculum and educational resources, including production of additional education resources, TV and radio programmes, and textbooks.
- Organization of assessment and high-stakes exams.
- Coordinated and targeted advocacy to support continuity of learning during COVID-19 and return to school, in particular, in countries with the greatest gender disparities in education.




> formal education wants to be sustainable by definition





formal education resonates with societal developments






- > paradigmatic shift from teaching to learning ← personalization


