- Islamic legal perspectives on bioethical dilemmas and emerging biotechnologies.
- Explorations of spirituality and the human condition in relation to transhumanist aspirations.
- Ethical considerations surrounding genetic engineering, artificial intelligence, and human enhancement technologies.

We welcome all scholarly contributions while explicitly encouraging submissions that explore philosophical and spiritual dimensions. This inclusive approach aims to foster a vibrant dialogue and to provide insights from diverse perspectives on this important and timely topic.

All submissions will undergo a rigorous peer-review process to ensure scholarly excellence. Manuscripts should adhere to the journal's guidelines for manuscript preparation and should be submitted by <u>December 1st, 2024</u>.
