

EBS 2025 – Admission and selection criteria

Admission criteria

Applications meeting the following requirements are eligible:

- Enrolment at the University of Trento/Free University of Bozen-Bolzano **or**
 - enrolment at a University in a European Union Member State **and** residence in the Province of Trento/Province of Bozen-Bolzano-South Tyrol;
- Bachelor's degree or, for single-cycle Master's degrees, having obtained 180 ECTS by the application deadline;
- Excellent knowledge of the English language (at least level B2 of the Common European Reference Framework);
- For the Autonomous Province of Trento only, candidates eligible for admission shall be citizens of an EU member State and be under 30 years of age, by the day of the application deadline.

Selection criteria

For the purposes of this selection process, enrolment at the University of Trento/Free University of Bozen-Bolzano is a preferential qualification. The selection process for admission to the “Course 800753 – Euregio Brussels School Redefining Europe” (from now on EBS - ‘Euregio Brussels School’) will be carried out by giving priority to applications from students from the two universities mentioned above and drawing up the relative ranking list. Only as a residual measure, if the places available at each university (10 places) are not filled, applications from residents in the corresponding territory will be selected and ranked until all available places are filled.

For both categories of applicants, the ranking list will be drawn up according to the following criteria:

- Bachelor's degree final grade¹:

Final grade	Points
110 – 110 cum laude	4
106 -109	3
100- 105	2
Up to 99	1

¹ If there is no final grade, the average grade of the exams successfully passed during the completed degree programme may also be indicated. The final grade of the degrees obtained or the average grade of the exams of the degree programme successfully completed abroad must be specified by the participant with the corresponding grades of the Italian university system, if possible.

Or, for students of single-cycle Master's degrees:

- Average grade of exams (single-cycle Master's degree)²:

Grade	Points
28/30 - 30/30	4
26/30 – 27,9/30	3
24/30 – 25,9/30	2
Up to 23,9/30	1

- For each successful exam in the Bachelor's degree and/or Master's degree or single-cycle degree with a clear reference to the European Union: 0.5 points (up to a max. of 4 points).

(The clear reference to the European Union must result from the title of the individual examination or seminar or exercise or from an official course description. If this does not result from the title and no official description is attached, the course or seminar will not be considered by the selection board).

- Traineeships and/or professional and/or training experiences in connection with European/international institutions and/or within the framework of EU programmes and/or projects (e.g. Erasmus): 0.2 points per week for periods of at least 4 weeks (up to a max. of 4 points)
- level of knowledge of the English language higher than B2, duly proven by an officially recognised certification (Cambridge, IELTS, TOEFL, Centro Linguistico di Ateneo), to be attached to the application form: 0.5 points.
- At the end of the assessment phases, in the event of a tie between candidates' score, priority shall be given to the younger candidate.

² Grades for exams, seminars and practices that have been successfully completed abroad must be specified by the participants with the corresponding grades of the Italian university system, if possible.
