is awarded for a thesis in the area of gender studies, women's studies and gender research completed at the University of Innsbruck. Dissertation/PhD, diploma and master theses completed at the University of Innsbruck within the past two years are to be submitted by **Monday, June 06 2022**

**Criteria and requirements**

- Eligible for submission are diploma and master theses, dissertations and PhD theses that include one (or multiple) theory/theories in the domain of feminist research, women's studies and gender research, queer studies, postcolonial or decolonial studies etc.
- A thesis can only be submitted once for this prize.
- It is required that the thesis has been completed at the University of Innsbruck within the past two years (key date January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020).
- The thesis has to be written in gender-inclusive and non-discriminatory language.

  - o Digital copy of the thesis (pdf)
  - o Short biography or CV of the person submitting the documents
  - o Short summary of the content of the thesis (max. 400 words)
  - o 3-5 key words describing the thesis (topic/content) and 2-5 keywords describing the disciplinary and/or interdisciplinary embedding of the thesis
  - o Information about previous awards and prizes if applicable
  - o For dissertations/PhD thesis: written assessment/evaluation
