

Foreword by the Rector












Degrees - Gender Ratio



Gender ratio of graduates in 2019/20



Base funding 2020








Open Access publications in Web of Science (WoS)

71.4% of all publications in Web of Science are co-authored with international scholars. 5,270 total





Professors per student



Development of number of professors in percentDevelopment of number of students in percent


