Join the Interdisciplinary CSL Course at VU Amsterdam, part of the Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP). Open to all Master's students from Aurora Universities, this course brings together students from diverse disciplines to develop innovative solutions for a sustainable future.

This edition we have two main topics:

- 1. In collaboration with the European research projects CLEVERFOOD, FOSSNET, and FOSTER, focuses on health and sustainable food systems. You'll work on practical cases, collaborating with researchers and non-academic stakeholders on food system transformation projects.
- 2. In collaboration with the Amsterdam-based Knowledge Alliance on Mental Strength, and European project - Re/Presenting Europe, focuses on mental health, resilience and healing. You'll work on practical cases, collaborating with researchers and nonacademic stakeholders on projects that focus on improving the mental wellbeing of the public.
