Tasks

Representation of the subject "Landscape Ecology" in research and teaching. Close cooperation with research groups at the Department of Ecology and participation in the cross-faculty research focus "Mountain Regions" are expected.

In teaching, the subject of "Landscape Ecology" will be covered in the curriculum of the Faculty of Biology. In addition, participation in the inter-university MA program "Environmental Management of Mountain Areas" is required.
