The annual Vis Moot is one of the most prestigious international competitions for law students with over 365 universities from more than 85 countries participating. It is a simulation of international commercial arbitration proceedings, where students submit written memoranda and plead before an arbitral tribunal just as real-life counsel do. The case file, referred to as the *problem* entails relevant legal issues relating to the international sale of goods and international arbitral procedure.
