

Publication fund
of the Research Area “Cultural Encounters - Cultural Conflicts”

Funding is provided for the publication of monographs, anthologies and editions, in particular qualification publications (outstanding MA theses, dissertations and habilitation theses), which were written at the University of Innsbruck and will be published by the end of 2024.

The printing costs will be funded with a grant of up to € 1,000, subject to available funds.

Award conditions and application documents

(1) Funding is available for publication projects from the humanities, cultural and social sciences as well as from theological disciplines at the University of Innsbruck, which are initiated and supported by at least one member of the Research Area “Cultural Encounters - Cultural Conflicts” (information on membership at fsp-kultur@uibk.ac.at).

(2) Qualification publications, publication projects with an interdisciplinary approach, projects with an open access strategy (green or gold) and publication projects that are subject to a peer review process are prioritized.

(3) The completed and signed form and all required enclosures must be submitted. These are:

- a. preliminary table of contents
- b. for qualification publications: all reviews
- c. a complete cost breakdown of the publication project
- d. an overview of other grants awarded or applied for

(4) Funding will be paid directly to the applicant upon submission of a hard copy and an original invoice. The entitlement to funding expires six months after the publication date stated in the application.

(5) Acceptance of funding is linked to the obligation to refer to the funding body in the title of the funded publication in the following form: “[Funded by the] Research Area ‘Cultural Encounters - Cultural Conflicts’ of the [Leopold-Franzens] University of Innsbruck”.

Applications can be submitted from now until **31.05.2024** at the latest. The applications will be reviewed by the FSP Advisory Board.

Applications with the required enclosures in pdf format must be entered into the project database by the responsible project database manager of the respective institute. At the same time, please send your application by e-mail to fsp-kultur@uibk.ac.at.
