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The core of this year’s phonetics workshop is once again the phonetic level of language in all its facets. Phonetics as a research area forges a bridge between many different disciplines and covers a broad variety of perspectives on spoken language by investigating speech production, speech signal and speech perception. Our goal is to foster the exchange on current topics in phonetic theory, methods, studies and technology and to bring together different disciplines and fields of study. Our Call for Papers asks newcomers to academia as well as experienced researchers to send in contributions to our workshop.

The contributions may cover any aspect of phonetics and speech technology, for example:

- Phonetic theory
- Methods and methodology in articulatory, acoustic and perceptual phonetics
- Variationist linguistics / Studies on dialect and standard / sociophonetics
- Speech perception and phonaesthetics
- Linguistic intersections (e.g. phonetics/phonology or phonetics/syntax)
- Phonetics in first language acquisition
- Phonetics in second language acquisition and language teaching
- Speech synthesis / speech recognition / speech technology

Presentations: 20 min presentation + 10 min discussion per contribution; the presentation is meant to be held on site. For specific cases, a presentation could also be held online.

Abstracts: A maximum of 300 words without references and figures in German or English. Please state the language of your presentation in the abstract.
