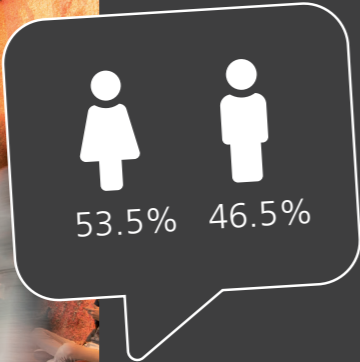
## Foreword by the Rector

This brochure provides an overview of the quantitative development of the Universität Innsbruck in recent years. The figures show the multiple and successful efforts of our alma mater to position itself as an important research and teaching institution in the national and international higher education landscape. The positive development of the Universität Innsbruck in recent years is evident in almost all key figures.

Unfortunately, even in 2021 we were not able to return to the usual research and teaching conditions. However, despite the enormous challenges we managed to maintain high quality in research and teaching over the last two years. I would like to mention the 2021 record figures of 4,337 degrees, 19,235 studies actively pursued, 1,500 articles published for the first time in top international journals and a total of 62.9 million euros in third-party funding.

Based on the quantitative development shown in this brochure, I firmly believe that our institution has overcome the crisis reasonably well. I would like to emphasise that each and every employee contributes to the success of our university. I would therefore like to express my sincere thanks to all employees for their extraordinary commitment and impressive dedication in research, teaching and administration in the second Corona Year 2021!

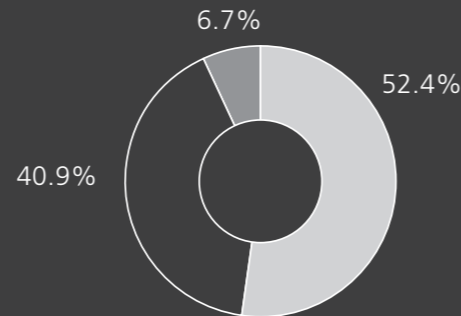

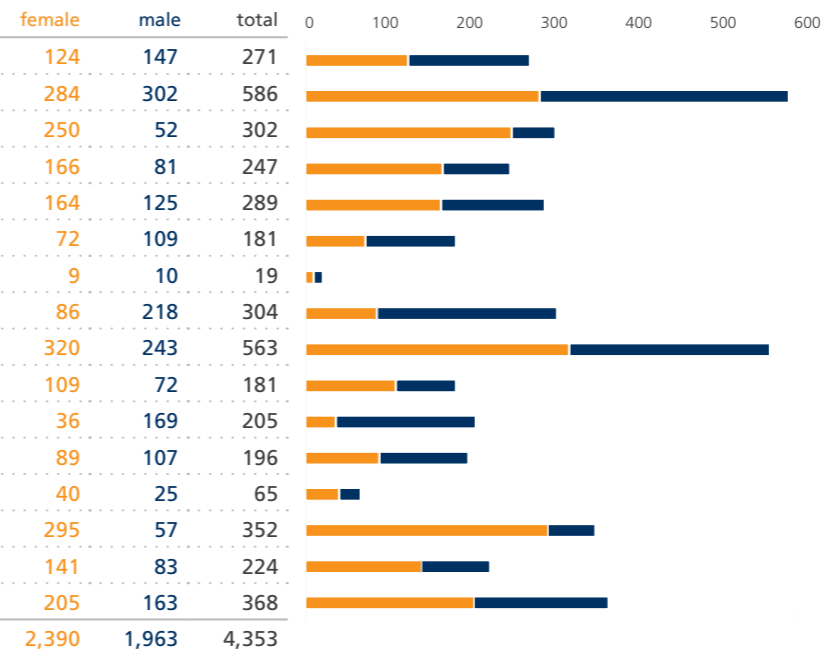

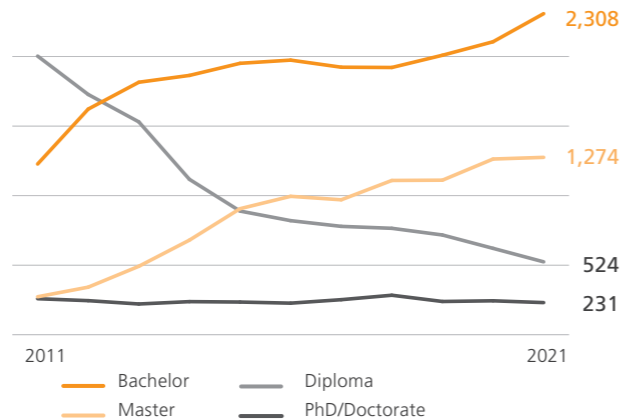

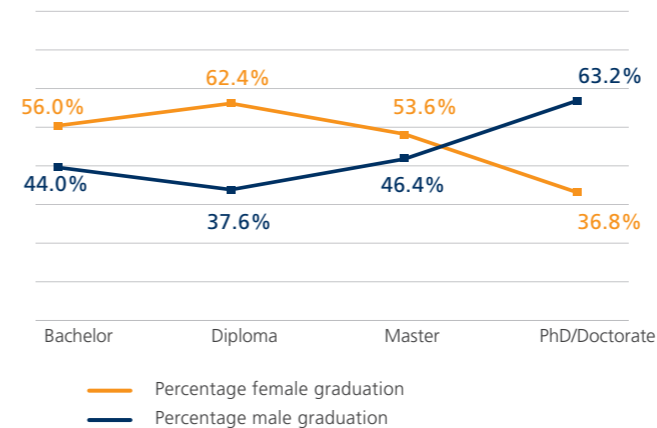
## Degrees awarded

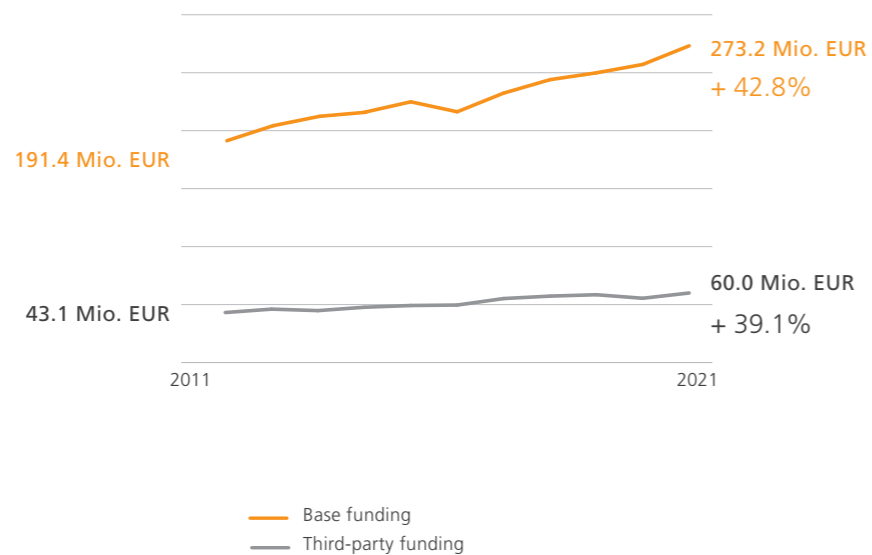
## 🎓 Degrees - Gender Ratio



### Gender ratio of graduates in 2020/21

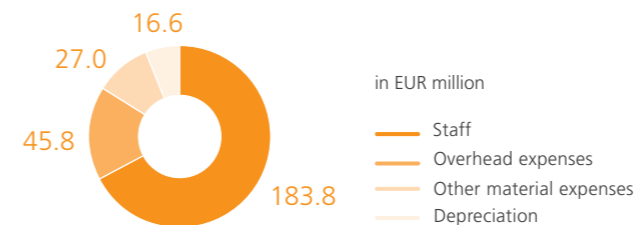

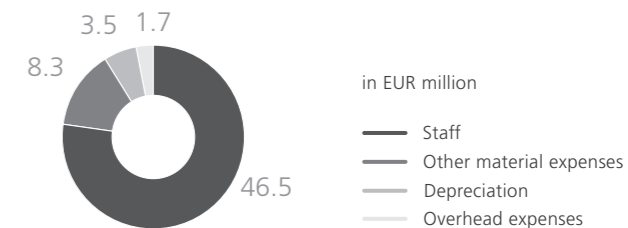

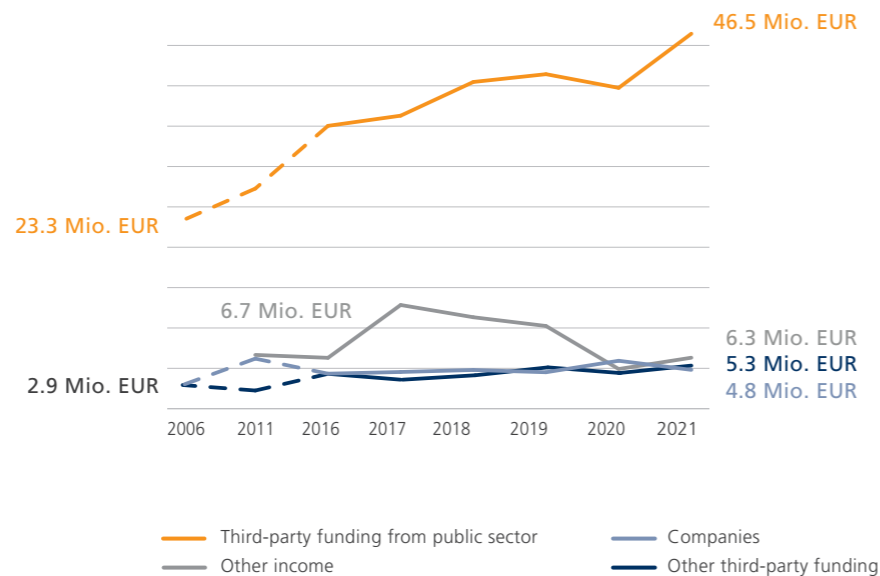

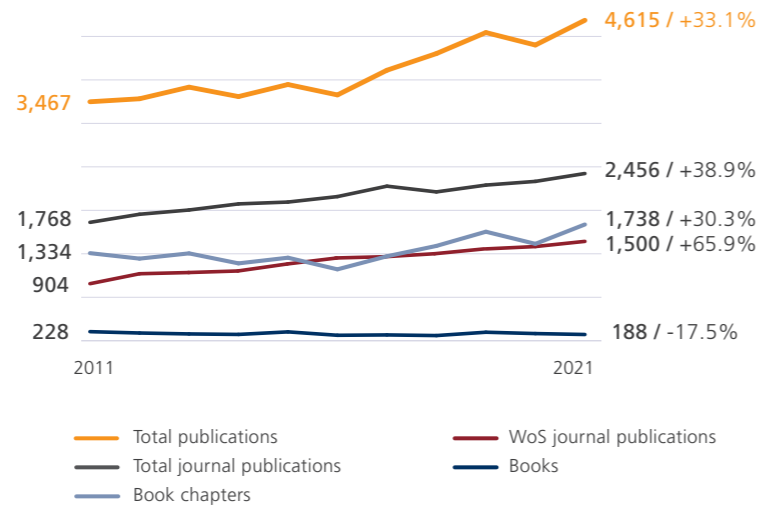

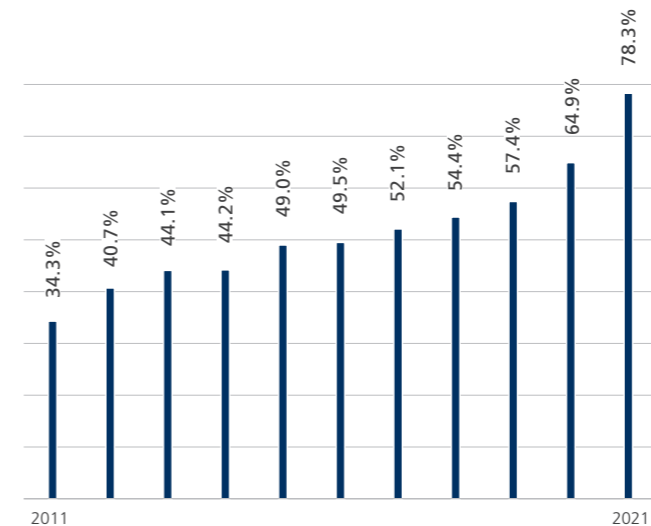

## Open Access publications in Web of Science (WoS)



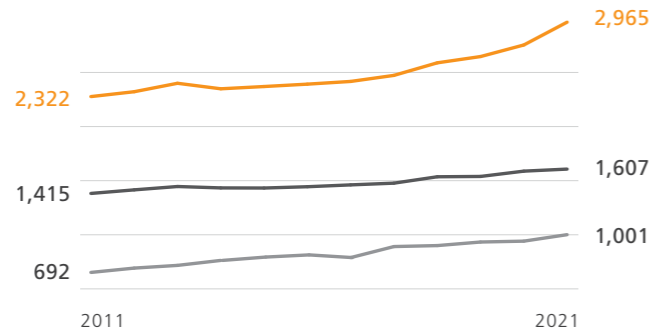
Percentage of Open Access publications in Web of Science

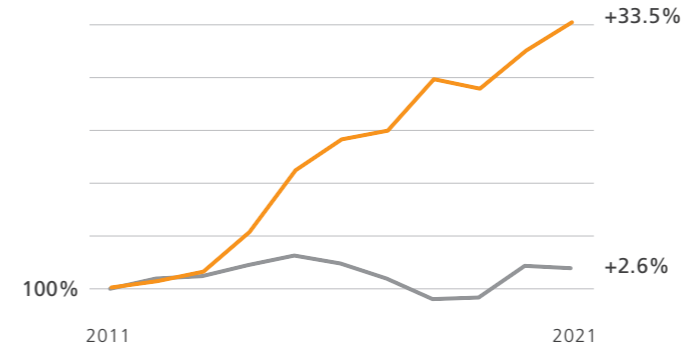

Professors per student



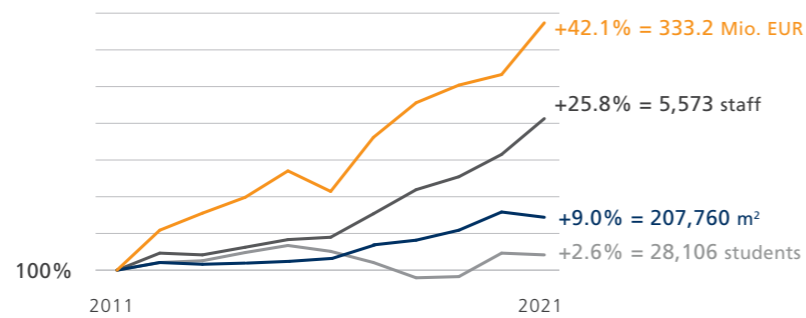

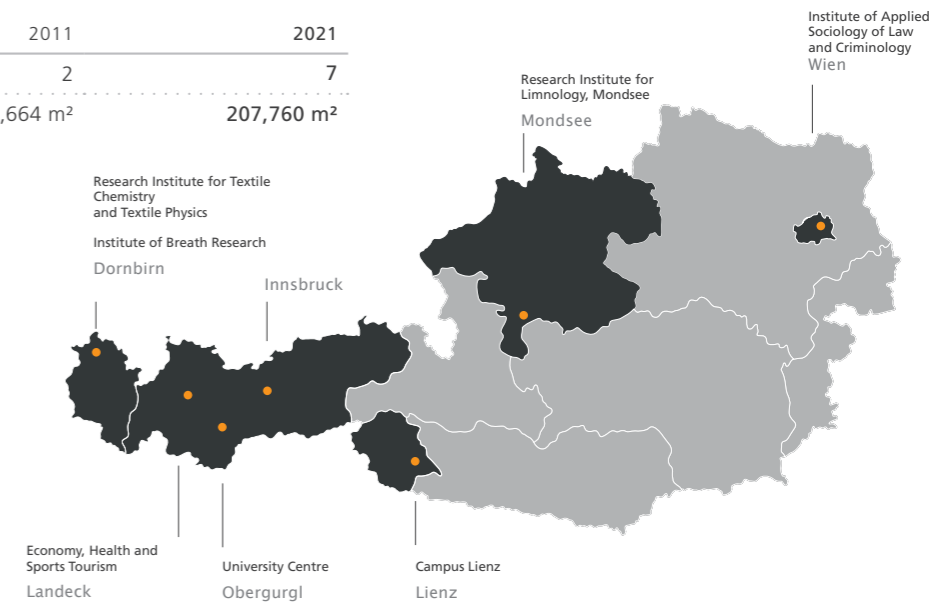
