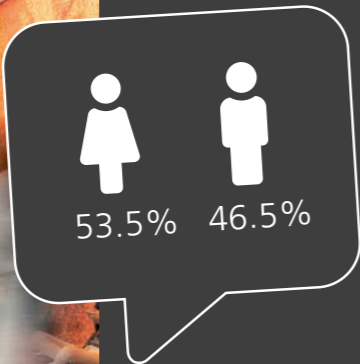
Foreword

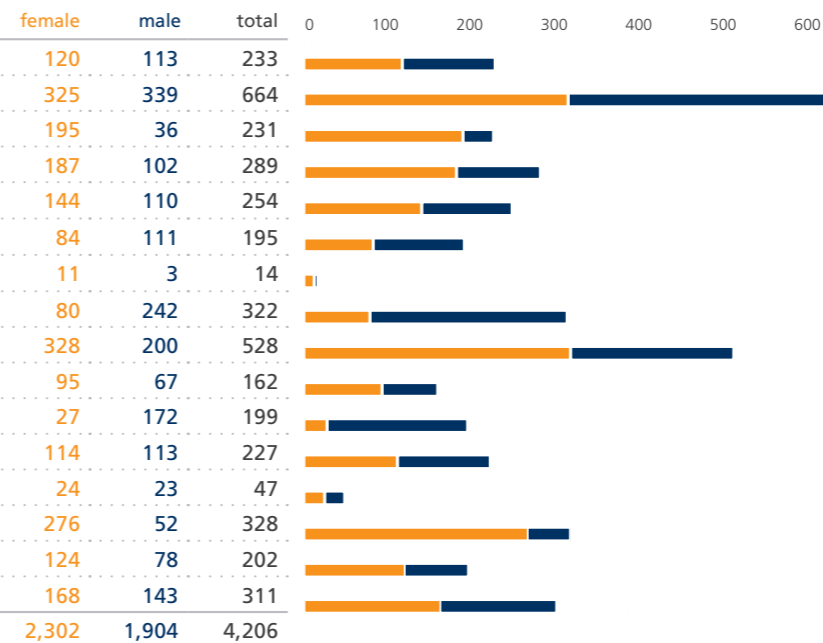

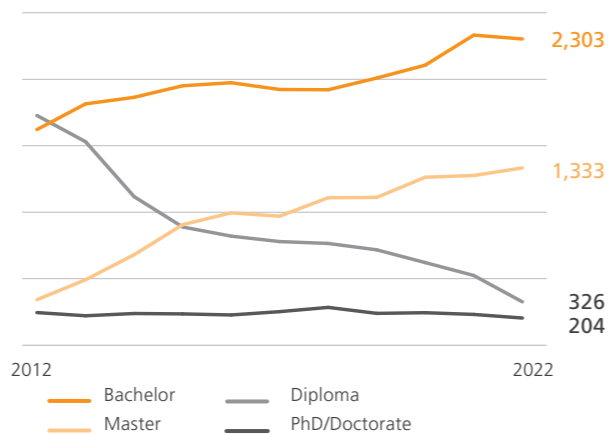

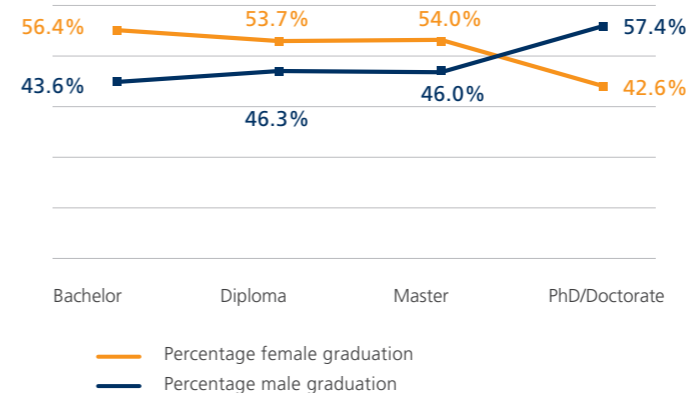

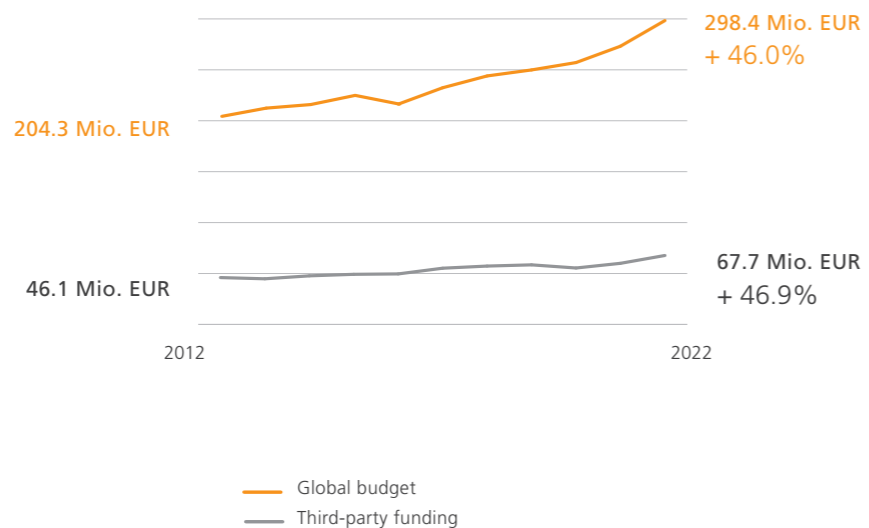
Graduation - Gender Ratio



Gender ratio of graduates in 2021/22

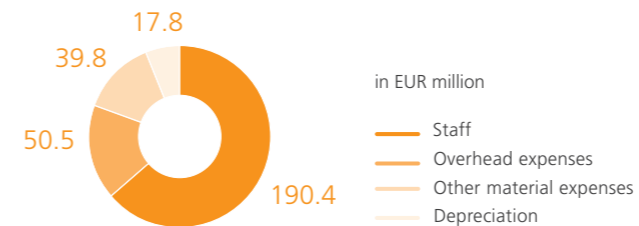

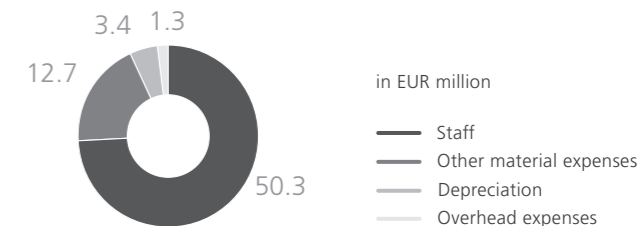

Global budget 2022

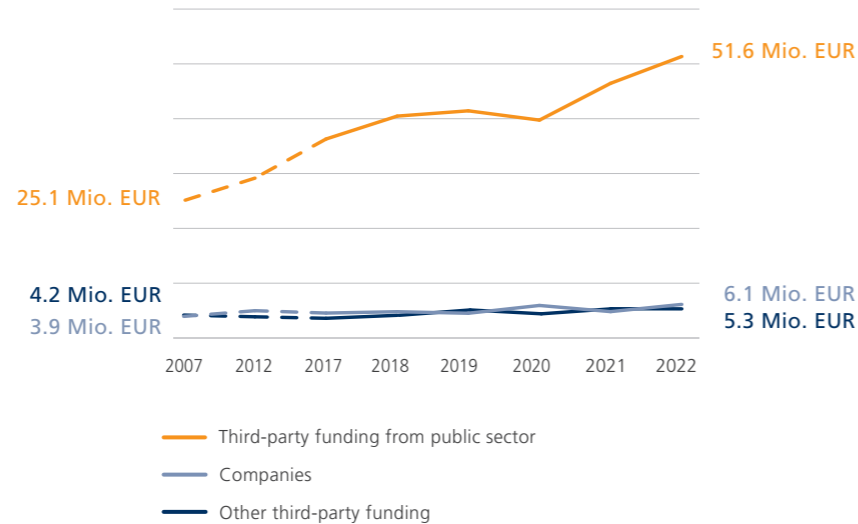

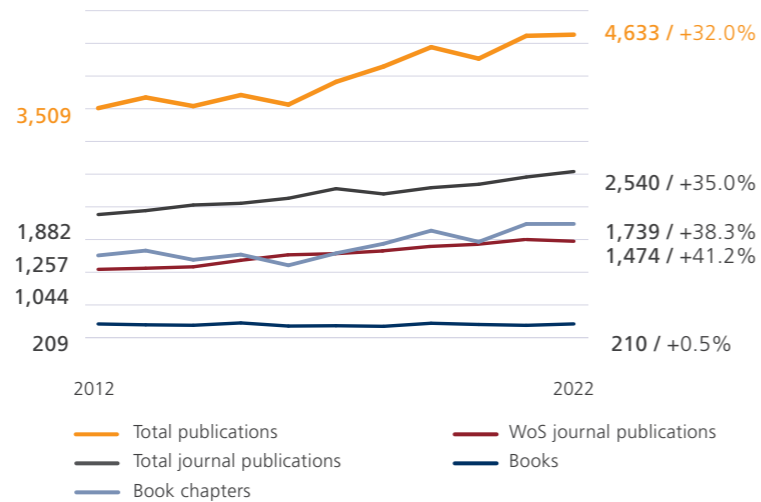

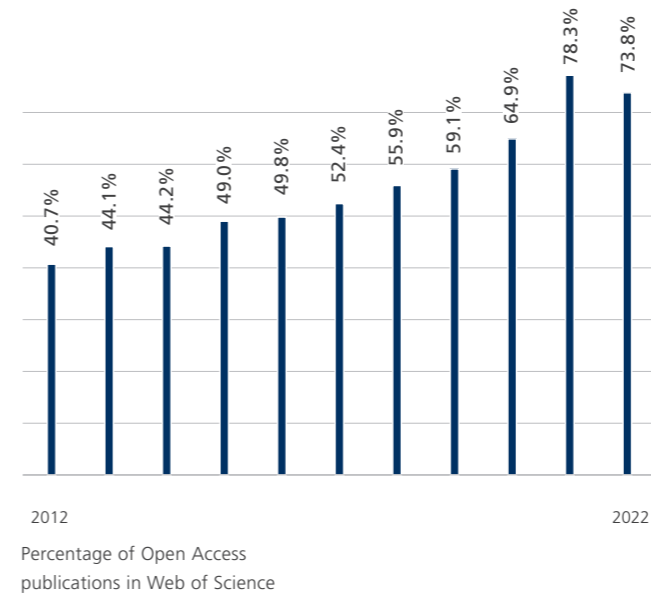

Long term development of publications



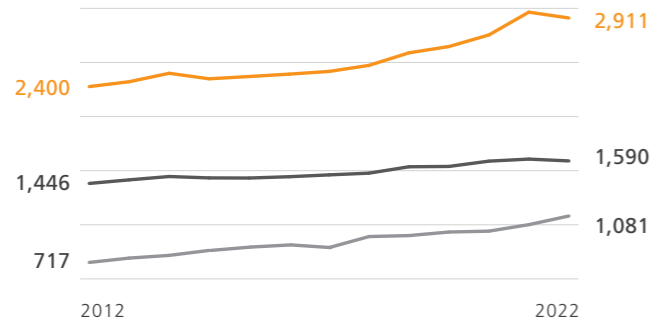
Open Access publications in Web of Science (WoS)

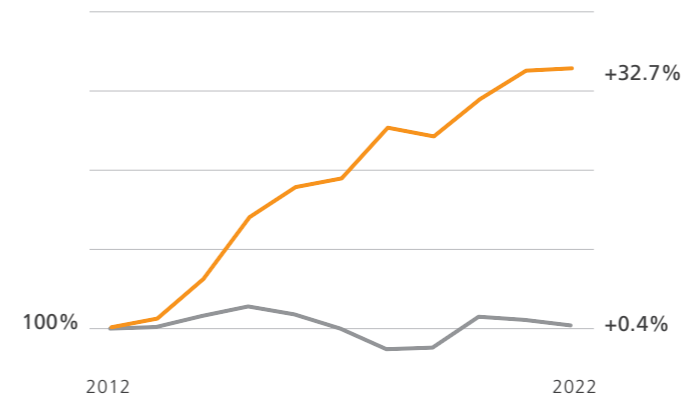

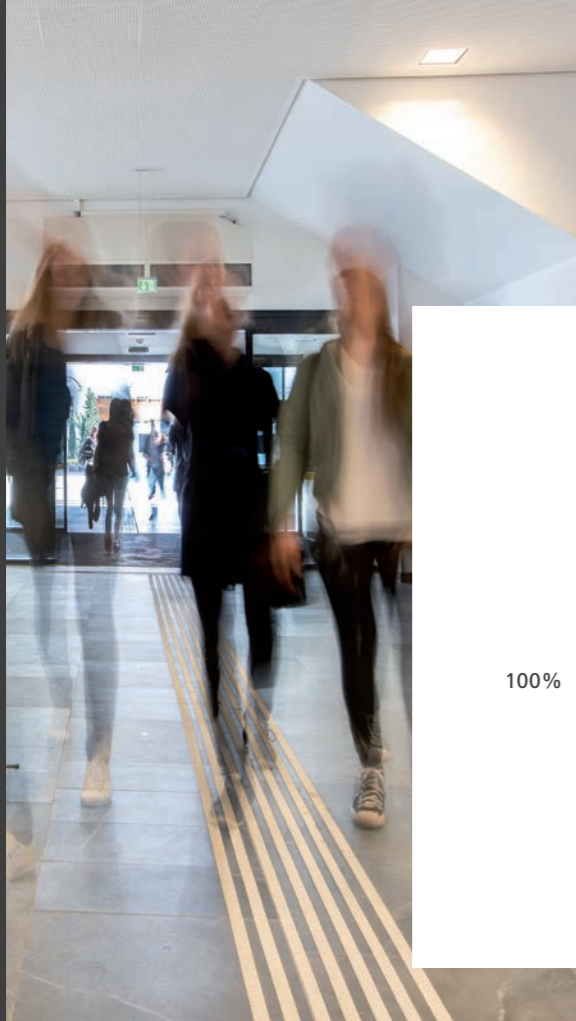
Professors per student



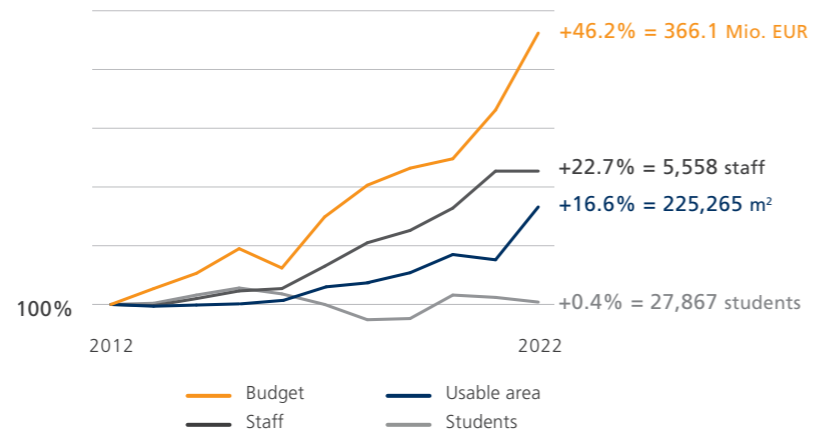

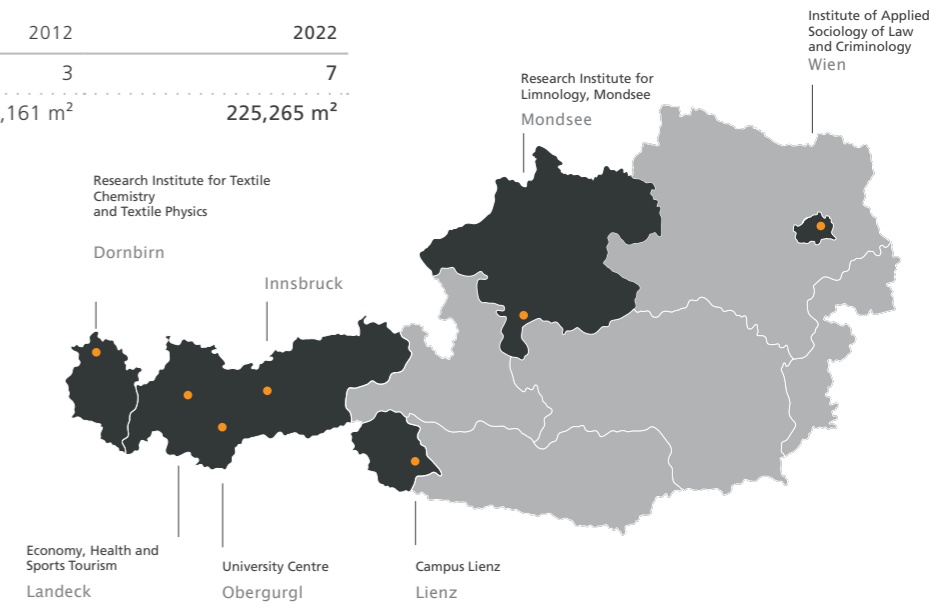
