

Visiting rules for the Botanical Garden

The house rules of the Leopold-Franzens University of Innsbruck apply.

Entering the garden area is allowed during opening hours under the following conditions:

- * Entering the garden area is at your own risk!
- * Children under 12 years are only allowed to enter when accompanied by an adult. Legal guardians are fully liable for the children they supervise and must ensure that the visiting rules are observed.
- * The University of Innsbruck is not liable for **damages** of any kind caused by non-compliance with the visiting rules. The perpetrators are liable for damages and their consequential costs.
- * Any **theft** will be reported to the police without exception!
- * The use of **unpaved paths** is at your own risk.
- * The instructions of the staff are to be followed immediately. In case of serious or repeated violations, persons may be excluded from the use of the garden by the Rectorate of the University of Innsbruck.

It is forbidden to:

- leave the paths and enter the lawn and planting areas, except areas specifically marked for this purpose
- * the use the garden naked, in swimwear or bare-chested
- * bring dogs with you
- * park or use bicycles, scooters, balls and other toys or sports equipment
- * pick and uproot plants and plant parts
- * **collect** fruits, seeds, berries, mushrooms and animals
- * remove or relocate any signs
- * damage or pollute any of the facilities and structures
- * stay under trees during a storm
- * climb on trees, facilities and structures.

Attention: we cultivate numerous poisonous plants!
