### Job Description

The areas of responsibility are as follows:

managing the collection of grape pomace during the harvest, ensuring proper storage for subsequent analysis; developing and optimizing protocols for extracting polyphenols from grape pomace, using innovative and sustainable techniques; characterizing the extracts obtained through mass spectrometry (LC-MS) and NMR; evaluating the antiamyloid activity of the extracts, understanding the molecular mechanisms and test the efficacy of the compounds against oxidative damage, with potential applications for neurodegenerative diseases like Huntington Disease.

### Requirements

Mandatory requirement:

- completed university studies of at <u>least four years</u> attested by a diploma in biology, biotechnology, natural sciences or similar.
- knowledge of Italian or English or German (will be evaluated during the interview).

Desired additional competences constituting evaluation criteria:

- experience in polyphenol extraction, purification and characterization using mass spectrometry.
- scholarships and research grants (please specify in your CV) in fields related to the position's research topics.
