### Continuation of the work on the online tool and the handbook

During the Christmas period and over the turn of the year, all project partners worked on the development of the online tool and the completion of the drafts for the handbook. The focus was especially on the further media development of the learning units of the online tool. The partners created first videos using Videoscribe and recorded podcasts.

### Digital project meeting on 15.02.2023

On 15.02.2023 the first digital project meeting of the partners took place in the new year. At the meeting, a very fruitful exchange took place about the current status of the project. The first completed learning units of the individual project partners were presented, tested and discussed. The resulting feedback helps all partners in the further development of the media content of the online tool. In addition, there was a lively exchange about the occurrence of technical questions during the creation of the creative content of the tool. In addition, intensive work was done on the manual and the drafts already produced were discussed. At the moment, fifty percent of the drafts for the manual have already been completed.

The structure of the website for the online tool was also presented and discussed at the meeting. Lastly, the work on the elements of the toolbox was continued.
