Christine Konecny (University of Innsbruck)

Christine Konecny is Associate Professor of Italian Linguistics at the Department of Romance Studies at the University of Innsbruck. Her research focuses on lexical semantics, contrastive and cognitive linguistics, and, in particular, phraseology and phraseography.

Between 2010 and 2016, she was the head of two research projects funded by the Autonomous Province of Bolzano-Alto Adige, the first of which (*Collocations Italian-German*) was in the field of phraseography and the second (*Lexeme combinations and typified speech in a multilingual context*) in the field of LCR. Since 2018, she has been involved in the phraseographic projects *GEPHRAS/GEPHRAS2* led by E. Autelli (https://romanistik-gephras.uibk.ac.at/), which are dedicated to the endangered variety of Genoese, and since 2021 in the *MetaKol* project led by A. Stojic at the University of Rijeka (https://metakol.uniri.hr/en/).

She also deals with questions of language learning and teaching, especially from the perspective of phraseodidactics, where she has developed a task-oriented, corpus-based textbook for Italian as L2 in cooperation with experts from the Department for Language Specific Education at the University of Innsbruck and from the Institute for Applied Linguistics at Eurac research, which was published by iup in 2021 (available as OER at https://www.uibk.ac.at/iup/buecher/9783991060451.html).

She recently co-edited, together with E. Autelli, the volume *Dialektale und zweisprachige Phraseographie* (Stauffenburg 2023) and the special issue *Fraseografia e metafraseografia delle varietà diatopiche* (*Linguistik online* 125/1, 2024, https://bop.unibe.ch/linguistik-online/issue/view/1352).
