Gill Philip is Associate Professor of English Language and Translation at the University of Macerata, Italy, where she teaches undergraduate and master's courses in English corpus linguistics, Italian-English translation, cognitive linguistics, and TEFL. Most of her research investigates aspects of the interplay between cognition and linguistic communication, particularly with respect to phraseology and figurative language. Her more recent work includes an ongoing exploration of how metaphorical language is interpreted and rendered over multiple translations produced by novice translators, and an in-depth investigation into the ways in which metaphorical space is invoked in academic language.
