

### **Carole Tiberius (University of Leiden)**

Prof. dr. Carole Tiberius is a senior researcher at the Instituut voor de Nederlandse Taal (INT, Dutch Language Institute) and professor of Computational Linguistics at the Leiden University Centre for Linguistics (LUCL).

She holds degrees from the Higher Institute for Translators and Interpreters in Antwerp and the University of Nijmegen (MA in Language, Speech and Computer Science) as well as a PhD from the University of Brighton on research into 'multilingual lexical knowledge representation'.

Her research interests lie in the domains of computational lexicography and corpus linguistics. She is primarily involved in contemporary lexicographic projects such as the *Vertaalwoordenschat*, an online multilingual dictionary and *Woordcombinaties*, a project combining collocations and pattern analysis for Dutch. She is one of the authors of *A Frequency Dictionary of Dutch* (published by Routledge in 2014).
