Lut Colman first followed teacher training in Dutch, English and history at the Institute Onze-Lieve-Vrouw ten Doorn in Eeklo. She then studied Germanic philology (Dutch and English) at the State University of Ghent. She did her graduate research in valence grammar with a thesis on lexical and syntactic aspects of locative and directive complements in Dutch.

Since 1990 she has been a researcher-linguist at the Institute for the Dutch Language (INT, formerly Institute for Dutch lexicology, INL), with phraseology as a special expertise. Until 2001 she worked as lexicographer on the Dictionary of the Dutch Language (WNT) and from 2001 to 2016 on the General Dutch Dictionary (ANW). Since 2017, she has been project leader/editor-in-chief of *Woordcombinaties*, a project integrating semantics and grammar.
