Valentina Piunno is Associate Professor in Linguistics at the University of Bergamo. She obtained a PhD in *Synchronic, Diachronic and Applied Linguistics* in 2013 at Roma Tre University, where she also took part in a national research project (*CombiNet* project, 2013-2016), dealing with the creation of a combinatory dictionary of Italian.

She is co-responsible (with Ada Valentini) for the project activity “DiaBerg: I dialetti bergamaschi in rete”, aimed at preserving, enhancing and disseminating the cultural heritage of the dialects of the area of Bergamo, and she is currently involved in the PNRR project “CHANGES - Cultural Heritage Active Innovation for Sustainable Society”.

She is interested in research on the lexicon and the application of computer resources in linguistics. In addition to several articles published in international journals, she wrote a monograph on Adjectival and Adverbial Multiword Constructions of Italian and other Romance languages (*Sintagmi preposizionali con funzione aggettivale e avverbiale*, Lincom, 2018). Her research interests include the study of the lexicon at the semantic/syntax interface, lexical semantics, diachronic linguistics, corpus linguistics, and combinatorial lexicography.
