Laura Rebosio is a PhD candidate at the Department of Translation Studies at the University of Innsbruck (supervisors: Laura Giacomini and Pius ten Hacken). She completed her studies at the University of Innsbruck with MA degrees in Translation Studies and in Linguistics. In her research, she focuses on lexical semantics and cognitive linguistics, in particular on the theoretical and practical challenges of identifying polysemy and representing it in online dictionaries for learners. Her research on polysemy is carried out in the framework of the PhraseBase project, a phraseologically and cognitively oriented lexical information system for different languages initiated by Laura Giacomini. Over the past eight years, Laura Rebosio has gained experience in foreign language teaching with learners of every age and background: Alongside several classes of Italian as a foreign language, she taught German as a second language to women with a migration background at the education and counselling centre *Frauen aus allen Ländern* in Innsbruck.
