## **TRANSLATA V** **INTERFACES IN TRANSLATION**

(19<sup>th</sup>–21<sup>st</sup> September 2024)

The 5<sup>th</sup> edition of TRANSLATA, the conference series of the Department of Translation Studies of the University of Innsbruck, will take place in Innsbruck, Austria from the 19<sup>th</sup>–21<sup>st</sup> of September 2024. The overall theme of this edition of TRANSLATA is *Interfaces in Translation*.

This year, TRANSLATA takes the format of a conference comprising individual thematic workshops organised and headed by various workshop leaders. There is also a general section to which all other presentations will be assigned. Within the workshops and the general section, the duration of presentations is scheduled for 30 minutes (20 minutes for presentation and 10 minutes for discussion). The preliminary workshop programme must then be submitted to the conference organisers by the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2024 and will be published on the conference website as soon as possible.

You are welcome to propose topics for the general section on all types of translation, theoretical and applied aspects of translation, and diverse translation studies paradigms.

Since its foundation, TRANSLATA has striven to promote multilingualism in its conference editions. Therefore, contributions can be submitted in all languages taught at our department (German, English, French, Italian, Russian and Spanish). Furthermore, we seek to promote German as a language of science in our field of research.

- Title of the presentation
- Abstract (max. 400 words in the language of the presentation)
- Five keywords
- Possible workshop you want to contribute to

The **conference fees** are as follows:

- Regular fee: €80
- Early bird fee (to be paid by 15<sup>th</sup> of July 24): €50
- Student fee: €25 (please mail a confirmation of study with the abstract)

The conference fee includes refreshments during breaks (coffee/tea, juice, biscuits), leisure programme (city tour or similar), and conference proceedings (with chapters by contributors). In the event of cancellation of a presentation (if cancelled after 18<sup>th</sup> August 2024) the conference fee cannot be refunded; in this case you can publish your full paper in the conference proceedings (in the event of a positive double review).
