The Dissemination of Angelo Poliziano's Latin Works in the German-Speaking Territories (1500-1550): Two Viennese Case-Studies

This paper examines the circumstances which led Latin works of Italian origin to receive attention in Renaissance Vienna. In my presentation I shall be looking at the ways in which two editions of Angelo Poliziano's writings (the "Lamia" and the "Nutricia") were produced in the city in the first half of the sixteenth century by two "local" humanists, Joannes Alexander Brassicanus and Joannes Ludovicus Brassicanus.
